Program Overview

- › Eligible Wall High School students will be able to earn their high school diploma while simultaneously earning an Associate's Degree from Brookdale Community College in either:
 - Social Sciences: This degree program prepares students for transfer to degree programs leading to careers in the mental health professions, law, teaching, consulting or the ministry
 - Science: This degree program prepares students for transfer to degree programs/majors in medical/life sciences, nursing, marine science, geology, or environmental science



Eligibility for Both Academies

- › Rising 9th grade students must meet eligibility requirements for honors level placement in:
 - Math (Algebra II Honors)
 - Science (Biology Honors)
 - English Language Arts (English 9 Honors)
 - Social Studies (Modern World History Honors)

- › At end of 9th grades students must pass the Accuplacer in reading, writing and math to continue Brookdale eligibility

Current 8th grade students who did not take placement tests will be given a second opportunity to do so if interested in one of the academies.

This would include non-resident students who are applying as tuition students.

Program Costs for Parents- Social Science

(all costs are maximum estimates at the present time)

- › 9th grade: \$129.75 (1 BCC credit)
- › 10th grade: \$778.50 (6 BCC credits)
- › 11th grade: \$1,297.50 (10 BCC credits)
- › 12th grade: \$1,946.25 (15 BCC credits)

- › Total estimated cost: \$4,152.00 plus cost of textbooks for Brookdale courses
- › Cost for AA degree at Brookdale: \$9,653.40



Program Costs

- › Courses taught at Brookdale by Brookdale faculty: \$129.75 per credit
- › Courses taught at Wall by Wall faculty approved as adjuncts by Brookdale: $\frac{1}{3}$ of \$129.75 per credit or \$42.81
- › Courses taught at Wall by Brookdale faculty (paid by Brookdale): $\frac{1}{2}$ of \$129.75 per credit or \$64.87



Advantages

- › Helps to define/clarify career aspirations before paying tuition at 4-year colleges or universities
- › Gradual transition to the rigor and expectations of post-secondary learning
- › Some colleges will transfer the full Associate's Degree towards satisfaction of 60 credits of a Bachelor's Degree
- › Graduate High School with an Associate's Degree
 - Potential to complete a Bachelor's Degree in two years (at ½ the cost)
 - Potential to complete a Master's Degree in the amount of time typically devoted to a Bachelor's
