The Wall Township Board of Education received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on July 28, 2016. On July 29, 2016 the district provided a partial response by providing the Budget Projection History Report for the 2006-07 school year, as previously stated, this was the first year that budget detail information was entered into the budget module of the accounting software.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:


"... Budget Projection: Account Detail report - Fiscal Years 2004/2005, 2005/2006, 2006/2007, 2007/2008, 2008/2009, 2009/2010, 2010/2011, 2011/2012, 2012/2013." [sic]

In response to your request, attached please find Budget Projection: Account Detail Reports for the 2007-08, 2008-09, 2009-10, 2010-11, 2011-12, and 2012-13 school years.

These records are being transmitted to you via pick up, as the file is too large to email. The cost associated with this request is \$51.15 (1,023 Pages).

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Wall Township Board of Education to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ 08625, by e-mail at [grc@dca.state.nj.us](mailto:grc@dca.state.nj.us), or at their web site at [www.state.nj.us/grc](http://www.state.nj.us/grc). The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
