The Wall Township Board of Education received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on July 28, 2016. The district provided a partial response on August 8, 2016 and requested an extension of time until August 19, 2016.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:


"... the cell phone bills for Mr. Smyth showing his phone calls ..., for the period, 4/1/2007 - 4/30/2016,..."

In response to your request for cell phone bills of Mr. Smyth, attached please find the district's Verizon Wireless bills for the 2012-13 and 2013-14 school years that are responsive to your request, with redactions, per Appellate Division Case of 2011, Livecchia v. Borough of Mount Arlington. We request additional time to provide records for the remainder of the school years requested and anticipate being able to provide the records by Friday, August 26, 2016.

These records are being transmitted to you via e-mail, as per your request. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.b., the cost associated with this request is \$0.00.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Wall Township Board of Education to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ 08625, by e-mail at [grc@dca.state.nj.us](mailto:grc@dca.state.nj.us), or at their web site at [www.state.nj.us/grc](http://www.state.nj.us/grc). The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
