Dear Ms. Cross,

The Wall Township Board of Education received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on July 27, 2016.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:

"...provide a check register report just for Dell payments breaking out the amounts from the general ledger, food service and any other Wall BOE bank account where Dell was paid. Please be sure to include the date of the check, the amount of the check and the check number. Please run these payments in date order and include a total at the end of each school year. Please keep the payments from the accounts separate ie, do not combine Dell food service payments with those made out of the General Ledger." [sic]

In response to your request, attached please find General Fund Check Register reports limited to the requested vendor for the 2015-2016, 2014-2015, 2013-2014, 2012-2013, 2011-2012, 2010-2011, 2009-2010, 2008-2009, 2007-2008, 2006-2007, 2005-2006, 2004-2005, 2003-2004, 2002-2003, 2001-2002, and the 2000-2001 school years along with Check Register reports for the Food Service Account limited to the requested vendor for the 2015-2016, 2014-2015, 2012-2013, 2008-2009, 2006-2007, 2005-2006, 2004-2005, and the 2003-2004 school years. Please be advised that no payments were made to Dell from the Food Service Account in the 2013-2014, 2011-2012, 2010-2011, 2009-2010, and the 2007-2008 school years.

These records are being transmitted to you via e-mail, as per your request. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.b., the cost associated with this request is \$0.00.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfiled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Wall Township Board of Education to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
