The Wall Township Board of Education received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on September 22, 2016.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:


"... the phone bills for Mr. Habel... from 1/1/2009 - 7/5/2012... [sic]"

It is noted that based on your verbal comments, this request is asking for the detailed backup for the cell phone bills of James Habel. Therefore, in response to your request for cell phone bills of Mr. Habel, attached please find the district's Verizon Wireless bills for the period of January 1, 2009 through July 30, 2012 that are responsive to your request, with redactions, per Appellate Division Case of 2011, Livechia v. Borough of Mount Arlington.

These records are being transmitted to you via e-mail, as per your request in response to our initial correspondence of September 30, 2016. Please be advised that this response is being provided in two separate scanned documents as the file is too large to scan as one document. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.b., the cost associated with this request is \$0.00 (consisting of 306 pages).

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfiled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Wall Township Board of Education to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
