The Wall Township Board of Education received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on September 26, 2016. The district requested an extension of time until October 14, 2016.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:


"... a copy of Brian Smyth's daily calendar, daily planner or daily schedule, whether kept in hard copy or electronic form. I am requesting this information from April 1, 2007 to September 26, 2016." [sic]

In response to your e-mail request of October 5, 2016 for a partial response of Mr. Smyth's daily calendar, covering the time frame of April 1, 2007 through June 30, 2009, attached please find Mr. Smyth's daily calendar, with redactions, from April 1, 2007 through June 30, 2009. As previously communicated to you, we request additional time to provide records for the remainder of the school years requested and anticipate being able to provide the records by Friday, October 14, 2016.

These records are being transmitted to you via e-mail, as per your request. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.b., the cost associated with this request is \$0.00.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfiled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Wall Township Board of Education to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
