On October 19, 2016 the Wall Township Board of Education received your follow-up Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request to the district's response dated October 18, 2016.


Your follow-up request stated:

"In response to your reply of today, I did not request the advertisement for the "internal" postings for the Assistant Business Administrator and Business Administrator for the Wall BOE that you sent me, I requested the "public" advertisements for Assistant Business Administrator and Business Administrator for the Wall BOE for years 2004 - 2009. This would include any publication including but not limited to, newspapers, magazine, trade journals and any online publications. " [sic]

Please be advised that on October 18, 2016 the district provided all records on file that were responsive to your request. For further clarification the district does not have copies of any public advertisements from years 2004-2009 on file that would be responsive to your request. Please be further advised that the candidate search in 2007 was conducted by the New Jersey Association of School Business Officials (NJASBO).

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Wall Township Board of Education to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
