To whom it may concern,

The Wall Township Board of Education received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on November 8, 2016.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:

"...a copy of any correspondence received from the Office of Fiscal Accountability and Compliance to Cheryl Dyer received after October 24, 2016. ...also a copy of any correspondence sent from Cheryl Dyer after October 24, 2016, regarding the letter/correspondence received from Fiscal Accountability and Compliance to any Wall BOE member and/or any member of Wall Administration advising them of the information contained in the letter and/or attaching the correspondence Ms. Dyer received from the Office of Fiscal Accountability and Compliance."

In response to your request, attached please find correspondence dated October 31, 2016, from the State Department of Education, Office of Fiscal Accountability and Compliance.

With regard to your request "...any correspondence sent from Cheryl Dyer after October 24, 2016, regarding the letter/correspondence received from Fiscal Accountability and Compliance to any Wall BOE member and/or any member of Wall Administration advising them of the information contained in the letter and/or attaching the correspondence Ms. Dyer received from the Office of Fiscal Accountability and Compliance."

Please know that in accordance with N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1, these documents are exempt from disclosure as "advisory, consultative, and/or deliberative material." Once the deliberative process is complete, you may resubmit an OPRA request.

These records are being transmitted to you via e-mail, as per your request. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.b., the cost associated with this request is \$0.00.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Wall Township Board of Education to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ 08625, by e-mail at [grc@dca.state.nj.us](mailto:grc@dca.state.nj.us), or at their web site at [www.state.nj.us/grc](http://www.state.nj.us/grc). The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
