5) A copy of the F&F minutes from July 1, 2003 with any attachments that were given to Wall BOE members." [sic]


In response to items numbered 1), 2), 3), and 4) please be advised the district has performed a search of district records and has determined that no records exist that would be responsive to your request.

At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
