- 3) Atlantic Business starting with the 2011/2012 school year through the present broken out by school year with a grand total at the end of each school year." [sic]


In response to item number one (1.), please know that these records have been destroyed, however, we still maintain an electronic database and we have created reports responsive to your request. Attached please find Savin Corporation Check Register By Vendor Name Reports for the 2001-2002, 2002-2003, and 2003-2004 school years. Please know that there are no documents responsive to your request from 2004-2005 to present.

In response to item number two (2.), attached please find Municipal Capital Corporation Check Register By Vendor Name Reports for the 2011-2012, 2012-2013, 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, and 2016-2017 school years. Please know that there are no documents responsive to your request for 2010-2011.

In response to item number three (3.), attached please find Atlantic Business Check Register By Vendor Name Reports for the 2011-2012, 2012-2013, 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, and 2016-2017 school years.

These records, totaling 105 pages, are being transmitted to you via e-mail, as per your request. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.b., the cost associated with this request is \$0.00.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Wall Township Board of Education to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
