The Wall Township Board of Education received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on January 10, 2017.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:


"...Cheryl Dyer's employment contract of Dec. 1, 2014 through June 30, 2019; the letter of approval from the State of New Jersey DOE; and the Sept. 23, 2014 meeting minutes evidencing the approval of the Superintendent's contract... all correspondence from Flavio Komuves, Esq. to Brian Smyth and/or Dawn Choma from Dec. 1, 2016 to Jan. 10, 2017 and all correspondence from Brian Smyth and/or Dawn Choma to Flavio Komuves, Esq. from the same time period."

In response to your request, attached please find Mrs. Cheryl Dyer's, Superintendent of Schools, Contract of Employment from December 1, 2014 through June 30, 2019, which is available on the district website, correspondence from the State of New Jersey, Department of Education approving Superintendent Dyer's Contract of Employment from December 1, 2014 through June 30, 2019, Combined Workshop/Regular Meeting Minutes of September 23, 2014, which are available on the district's website, correspondence from Flavio L. Komuves to Mr. Smyth, correspondence from Mr. Smyth to Flavio L. Komuves, and correspondence from Dawn Choma to Flavio L. Komuves.

These records, totaling 31 pages, are being transmitted to you via e-mail, as per your request. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.b., the cost associated with this request is \$0.00.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfiled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Wall Township Board of Education to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ 08625, by e-mail at [grc@dca.state.nj.us](mailto:grc@dca.state.nj.us), or at their web site at [www.state.nj.us/grc](http://www.state.nj.us/grc). The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
