The Wall Township Board of Education received your Immediate Access Open Public Records Act (OPRA) on April 3, 2017.

Your Immediate Access request sought access to the following:

"... the bills for the past year for all outsourced transportation costs for the Wall BOE..." [sic]


In response to your request, attached please find the following:

- Purchase order 17-01044, Purchase Order Pay-down Schedule for P.O. No. 17-01044 and invoicing for outsourced transportation from Monmouth-Ocean Educational Services Commission for the period of July 2016 and August 2016;
- Purchase order 17-01776, Purchase Order Pay-down Schedule for P.O. No. 17-01776 and invoices for outsourced transportation from Monmouth-Ocean Educational Services Commission for the period of September 2016 through November 2016;
- Purchase order 17-02220, Purchase Order Pay-down Schedule for P.O. No. 17-02220 and invoices for outsourced transportation from Monmouth-Ocean Educational Services Commission for the period of December 2016 through February 2017;
- Purchase order 17-00350, Purchase Order Pay-down Schedule for P.O. No. 17-00350, and payment vouchers from July 2016 through March 2017 for a 2016-2017 Parental Contract for Student Transportation.

These records, totaling 45 pages, are being transmitted to you via e-mail, as per your request. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.b., the cost associated with this request is \$0.00.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Wall Township Board of Education to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
