The Wall Township Board of Education received your Immediate Access Open Public Records Act (OPRA) on April 27, 2017.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:

"...application for use of the Central School Fields that the F&F committee approved from the Union City Men's Soccer League. I am aware that Wall F&F Committee agreed to 24 week program where they would pay \$50 a week to the Wall BOE." [sic]


In response to your request, attached please find the following:

- Union Soccer, Application to Use School Facilities, dated November 7, 2016.
- Certificate of Liability Insurance naming the Wall Township BOE as additional insured.
- Correspondence dated January 24, 2017, from Union Soccer League.
- Email Correspondence from Virginia Pagnoni, Central Elementary School Secretary to Kathleen Hurley, Business Services Coordinator, dated November 8, 2016.
- Invoice dated January 27, 2017, from Wall Twp. BOE, in the amount of \$1,850.00, to Union Soccer League.
- Check number 306, dated March 2, 2017, in the amount of \$1,850.00, from JLGG Construction LLC, to Wall Twp. BOE for use of soccer field.
- Correspondence dated April 28, 2017, from Wall Twp. BOE to Union Soccer League revoking permit with refund check number 102764, dated April 28, 2017 in the amount of \$1,450.00.

These records, totaling 8 pages, are being transmitted to you via e-mail, as per your request. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.b., the cost associated with this request is \$0.00.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfiled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Wall Township Board of Education to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ 08625, by e-mail at [grc@dca.state.nj.us](mailto:grc@dca.state.nj.us), or at their web site at [www.state.nj.us/grc](http://www.state.nj.us/grc). The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
