Dear Guidance Office,

As students prepare their college applications, they should be aware of scholarship opportunities available for their higher education. The New Jersey State Golf Association Caddie Scholarship Foundation encourage those qualified students at your high school to apply for the NJSGA Caddie Scholarship.

Now in its 69th year of consecutive operation, the Caddie Scholarship Foundation has provided over \$12,000,000 in college scholarship awards. Currently, the Foundation is providing 178 caddies to over 100 colleges and universities across the country with over \$780,000 in scholarships.

Caddie scholars are selected based on their academic performance, financial need, and length and quality of service as a caddie (minimum of two seasons). Scholarships are renewable for up to four years of undergraduate study.

Applications for the 2017-18 academic year are available at www.njsga.org, they may be requested from the NJSGA office, or from the students' golf professional or caddie master. Also, enclosed is a hard copy of the application. In conjunction with their application, high school seniors should submit their high school transcripts, SAT scores and parents' tax return.

Please post this opportunity for all students in your scholarship bulletin and encourage application. GENERAL INFORMATION

The New Jersey State Golf Association (NJSGA) Caddie Scholarship is available to qualified applicants who have caddied at a participating NJSGA club for at least two seasons. Full-time attendance as an undergraduate at an institution of higher education accredited by the U.S. Dept. of Education is required. Children of private golf club members are not eligible for scholarships.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

1. Complete the applicant's section and have your golf club's Caddie Master attest to your eligibility.
2. Have your parents (or guardian) complete the last section and attached a signed copy of pages 1 & 2 of their 2015 or 2016 Federal Income Tax Return.
3. If you are a high school senior, submit a copy of your high school transcript, including your cumulative Grade Point Average, and College Board SAT (or ACT) scores.
4. If you are currently enrolled in college, submit a copy of your college transcript, including the 2016 Fall Semester.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The NJSGA Scholarship Committee reviews applications using the following criteria:

- College Board SAT (or ACT) scores
- Financial need
- Qualities of character and leadership
- Golf Club's financial support of the program
