

Wall High School Bus Information

Bus REGULATIONS

The following regulations apply to all students riding the school buses:

1. The bus driver represents an extension of the authority of the school.
2. The driver is in complete charge of the bus and the passengers. The driver may assign specific seats to students if he or she deems it necessary
3. Orderly conduct must be maintained at all times.
4. Students must only ride their assigned bus. Permission to ride another bus will **only be granted for an emergency situation**. Parents must contact the school by phone or written note about the situation prior to 12:15 p.m. of the school day (or by 10:15am on early dismissal days) so that an administrator can give approval for students to ride another bus.
5. Students are to remain seated at all times on the bus. Heads and hands are to remain inside the windows.
6. Students may have their riding privilege suspended for repeated or egregious bus violations.

BUS TRANSPORTATION

The following buses are provided for students who remain after school for:

4:00 p.m. Buses

- Extra Help
- Detention (Teacher & Central)
- Scheduled Supervised Student Activities (clubs, etc.)

5:15 p.m. Buses

- Inter-Scholastic Athletics (Practice & Games)
- Scheduled Supervised Student Activities

DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURE FOR SCHOOL BUS PROBLEMS

The following disciplinary procedures have been approved as Board policy to govern the general conduct of all pupils transported to school.

1. At the first sign of misconduct, there will be a verbal warning given by the bus driver.
2. If misconduct continues, a "Student Conduct Report" will be made out by the bus driver and submitted to the Assistant Principal and to the Transportation Supervisor for discipline.
3. The Assistant Principal may contact the parents and ask for their cooperation. (If necessary, the bus driver will be consulted).
4. If misconduct continues, the bus driver will again inform the Assistant Principal and the Transportation Supervisor by a "Student Conduct Report". The student will again be disciplined.
5. The student will be denied transportation for a period of one week for subsequent infractions. His/her parents will then be expected to provide the necessary transportation.
6. If misconduct continues, more stringent action will be taken.
