-Tin and Aluminum Cans

-Paper

(Includes: Office Paper, Newspaper, Magazines, Cardboard, **Paper Bags, Juice Boxes, Milk Cartons**)

-**ALL** Plastics

(Includes: Water Bottles, Milk Bottles, **Yogurt Containers, Plastic Forks and Knives, and Plastic Containers from the Cafeteria**)
