Dear Parent/Guardian,

It is the policy of the Wall Township Public School District to require mandated \*immunizations through the New Jersey State Sanitary Code, Chapter 14. These requirements are applicable to all children attending New Jersey Schools.

Specifically:

1. **DPT:** A minimum of four (4) doses is required.
2. **Tdap:** All students born after 1/1/1997, and entering Sixth (6<sup>th</sup>) grade. One (1) dose after 10<sup>th</sup> birthday.
3. **Polio:** Minimum of three (3) doses.
4. **Rubeola:** Two (2) doses administered on/or after first (1<sup>st</sup>) birthday.
5. **Rubella:** One (1) dose administered on/or after first (1<sup>st</sup>) birthday.
6. **Mumps:** One (1) dose administered on/or after first (1<sup>st</sup>) birthday.
7. **HIB:** (Haemophilus Influenza) one (1) dose (pre-school only).
8. **PVC:** (Pneumococcal conjugate vaccine) One (1) dose on or after the first birthday for all children ages 11-59 months.
9. **Influenza:** One (1) dose between Sept 1 and Dec. 31, annually, for all children ages 6-59 months.
10. **Hepatitis B:** Three (3) doses required for school entry.
11. **Varicella:** One (1) dose on or after the first birthday or proof of disease immunity for all children born after 1/1/1998.
12. **Meningococcal Vaccine:** One (1) dose for all students born after 1/1/1997, entering or attending grade six and upon turning 11 years of age.
13. **Tuberculosis:** Mantoux intradermal skin test to screen for exposure to tuberculosis may be required.

The Wall Township Board of Education may exempt any pupil from the immunizations listed above (with the exception of those mandated by the State Board of Education) if a parent or guardian of said pupil objects thereto in a written statement signed by him/her, upon the grounds that the proposed immunization is medically contraindicated or interferes with the free exercise of his/her religious principals, as amended L.1952, c.153,p.514,p.1.

NO STUDENT TRANSFERRING FROM WITHIN THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY CAN REGISTER WITHOUT ALL THE VACCINES LISTED. OUT OF STATE STUDENTS MAY ENTER, AND PARENTS ARE GIVEN THIRTY (30) DAYS TO COMPLY.

**\*The listed immunizations are intended to establish the minimum vaccine requirements for school attendance. Please consult with your health-care provider for information on providing optimal protection for your child through additional vaccinations as recommended by the American Academy of Pediatrics and the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices.**
